

#### **Tophane Square**

Tophane fountain is in Tophane Square -outside of the historical peninsula of Istanbul- the Tophane Fountain is one of the best examples of 18th-century (Tulip period) Ottoman rococo architecture.

#### **Historical Bursa Castle**

The Clock Tower is renowned not only for its beauty and panoramic view but also for its historical significance, as it stands near the tomb of the founder of the Ottoman Empire, Sultan Osman Ghazi.



#### **Historical Bursa Grand Mosque**

The Grand Mosque of Bursa (Turkish: Bursa Ulu Cami) is a historic mosque in Bursa, Turkey. It was commissioned by the Ottoman Sultan Bayezid I to commemorate his great victory at the Battle of Nicopolis and built between 1396 and 1399. The mosque is a major monument of early Ottoman architecture and one of the most important mosques in the city, located in the heart of the old city alongside its historic markets.

### Silk market and Koza (Cocoon)Inn

Bursa, the first capital of the Ottoman Empire, was also its center of silk production and trade. Particularly in the 14th to 16th centuries, a large number of commercial structures such as hans (caravanserais), bazaars (covered markets), and a bedesten were built in the city center, forming a major zone of economic activity
